- Thanks to Ms. Langlois and Mrs. Spinks for organizing our School Spirit Days. Animal Day, Pink Shirt, Day and 100s Day were hits! The next Spirit Day is St. Patrick's Day (March 17) when everyone is invited to wear Green and Gold.
- Thanks to Mrs. Adamson for organizing our Harmony Day events. Our grade 5s went into Kelowna with grade 5 students from throughout the district to see keynote speaker Ian Tyson.

Early Learning for Families (ELFF) Night. On Wednesday, April 19, we are inviting families of preschool aged (3-5 years old) children to an Early Learning for Families (ELFF) Night in the Davidson Road Elementary School gym from 4:00-5:00pm. Families and their preschool aged child will get a chance to meet some of our staff (including the Kindergarten teachers), mingle with other families with soon-to-be Kindergarten students, and receive an early learning package as well as a yummy popsicle treat. The early learning package includes books, math manipulatives, and supplies that will help your child prepare for school.

We will be sending out an email with details about ELFF night to our new Kindergarten registrants. We also will put an ad in our newsletter. We will be asking families to RSVP via a Google link with the school so that we have an adequate number of learning packages for this event. Kindergarten Orientation is a different event and will take place on June 7.

DRE Outdoor Learning Enhancement Project Update. As mentioned at the February PAC meeting, Operations is in the process of building their spring and summer schedule. They hope to begin construction in late May. Moving forward, the district has put all new enhancement requests on hold.

The PAC has a credit balance of \$25,457.92 in the DRE Outdoor Learning Space Enhancement account. \$33,000 was deposited (from PAC) in June of 2021 and one invoice to Barco Products was paid out of this account in April 2022 for \$7,542.08 (four picnic tables).
