- Teachers participating in professional development and getting classes ready to welcome our students
- 2) Opening Week
  - Tuesday is our first day back for gr. 1 − 5 students
    - i. 393 students as of today (we were projected for 393)
  - Need to alter our Kindergarten plans for Tuesday
  - Health and Safety
    - i. Communicable Disease Plan (District Link School District website)
    - ii. DRE Communicable Disease plan (to be finalized with our JOHSC) and will be emailed out in newsletter later this week with a draft
      - Daily Health Check -<u>https://www.k12dailycheck.gov.bc.ca/healthcheck?execution=e1s1</u>
      - 2. Individuals who are ill or presenting symptoms will go home
      - 3. Staggered and controlled entry through designated entrances
      - 4. Hand Hygiene (Hand washing/hand sanitizer)
      - 5. Physical Spacing strict physical distancing not required
        - a. Create space and spread people out
        - b. Establish occupancy limits
        - c. Manage flow of people/students in common areas
        - d. Current limit of 50 individuals for gatherings
      - Masks are required indoors and on school busses for adults and students in grades 4 and 5. Students in K – 3 are encouraged to wear masks indoors and on busses. Masks are not required outdoors (not during PE.)
      - 7. Students are not in learning groups
      - 8. Limited entry into the building Hot lunch and volunteers on hold for now
